RESOLUTION of the Matawa Chiefs passed at the 34th Annual General Meeting in Webequie First Nation to be effective from and after 1:00 pm Eastern Standard Time on July 26, 2022.

RESOLUTION #22-28-07-2022

SUPPORT FOR CAPITAL IN MATAWA FIRST NATION COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

WHEREAS the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly, recognize the importance of Indigenous curriculum in Matawa First Nations Schools; and

WHEREAS there is a lack of capital infrastructure in First Nation schools at the community level to implement Indigenous curriculum, and;

WHEREAS the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly are aware that indigenous student learning and achievement levels, grade gaps, attendance and retention are impacted by the lack of capital infrastructure at the community level; and;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly recognized the number of deficiencies at the First Nation level from lack of infrastructure, lack of teacher accommodations, lack of resources, lack of school space, and:

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct the Matawa Education Department, Matawa First Nation Management and Matawa Education Spokesperson to lobby Canada and Ontario for educational capital funding.

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Education Department provide regular capital updates to the Matawa education leadership and to the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly.
