### APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEFS' SPOKESPERSON FOR EDUCATION

**WHEREAS** Matawa Chiefs' Resolution 2009/#10 & 2022/#06 mandated the appointment of a Chiefs' Spokesperson for Education to advocate at the regional, provincial, and federal levels for educational issues and proposals related to Matawa students, schools, education authorities, and education initiatives, and;

**WHEREAS** the term for the Matawa Chiefs' Spokesperson for Education is two years or until the appointed Spokesperson is no longer able to fulfil this responsibility, and;

**WHEREAS** the position of Matawa Chiefs' Spokesperson for Education is currently vacant, and there are education issues pending which would benefit from political advocacy, so;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly appoint Cornelius Wabasse as the Matawa Chiefs' Spokesperson for Education for two years, or until the said person is no longer able to fulfil this responsibility, and;

**FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct Matawa Education to ensure the Matawa Chiefs' Spokesperson for Education is kept current on issues and opportunities related to education policies, programming, funding, and regional education strategic planning.
