Matawa Housing operates 21-bed units for men and women over the age of 18 who have a critical need for housing and who wish to take their first steps towards independence. This short-term/transitional type of housing includes 24-hour staff support. An intake form needs to be completed to utilize the program. Walk-ins are not accepted in our secure building.

Living Space & Guidelines

Each unit contains a bed, desk, fridge, closet and shared spaces for food, lounge, etc.

Eligibility

Matawa community members with no stable housing are preferred. Eligibility also includes people on the rent-geared-to-income waitlist or are an Ontario Works or Ontario Disability Support Program recipient.

Participant Requirements

Adults who want to focus on training, schooling, and/or wellness; those experiencing homelessness who want to take steps to gain new life skills; and those traveling from home First Nation communities to seek schooling or training.
