Summary: The Matawa Chiefs Council invites any interested and qualified Matawa First Nation member to submit

their name for consideration as an appointment to TBMFTC to serve as a representative of the Matawa

Tribal Council as a Director.

Qualifications / Requirements:

• Each Director shall be a natural person at least eighteen (18) years of age

• Each Director shall be a member of a First Nation which is a member of TBMFTC

• No Director shall be an undischarged bankrupt, or mentally incompetent

• No Director who has been convicted of a criminal offence, for which he is not eligible for a pardon, may become a member of the Board

• No Director shall be an employee of TBMFTC

To be determined and subject to Matawa Tribal Council's right to replace a Director at any time.
