Position: Supply Teacher

Background: Formed in 1988, Matawa First Nations Management (Matawa) is a Tribal Council providing services to nine member communities in Northern Ontario. The organization is dedicated to providing its members with advisory and support services in the areas of communications, economic development, education, finance and business, health, membership and technical services.

The Matawa Education Department supports quality, accessible, community-based educational services for eight Matawa First Nations communities of Aroland, Eabametoong, Nibinamik, Long Lake #58, Ginoogaming, Neskantaga, Marten Falls, and Webequie First Nations. In addition to providing advisory services to Education Authorities and Matawa First Nation leadership, the Education Department administers post-secondary support services for 5 Matawa First Nations; operates the Matawa Learning Centre, a private secondary school located in Thunder Bay; and coordinates the Student Nutrition Program for 6 communities.

Matawa is inviting applications for the position of **Supply Teacher** with the Matawa Education and Care Centre

Position Summary: Under the direction and supervision of the Executive Director of Education, Matawa Education and Care Centre (MECC) Principal and Vice-Principal, the MECC Supply Teacher is responsible for assisting in the development and implementation of education programming for students at the MECC.

The MECC Supply Teacher provides instruction and support to students as they move toward the successful completion of their secondary education and continue on their pathways to work, training or post-secondary education programs. The MECC Supply Teacher facilitates learning in a variety of subject areas, and assists with the on-going development of courses and enrichment of curriculum to meet the needs of the MECC's students.

Preferred Qualifications and Experience:

- Qualifications as a secondary school teacher
- Experience teaching in a First Nation school and/or teaching First Nation students
- Knowledge and experience in developing courses and curriculum, and in utilizing ILC course materials





- Demonstrated instructional skills in a multi-grade setting
- Excellent written, verbal, interpersonal, presentation, and analytical skills
- A valid Ontario Driver's License
- Current *Certificate of Qualification and Registration* with the Ontario College of Teachers
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively with parents, students, co-workers, and administrator
- Willingness and ability to travel as required, to both road-accessible and fly-in communities
- Ability to speak Ojibwe, Cree or Oji-Cree is an asset

The successful applicant will be required to submit a current Criminal Record Check and TB skin test. This is a (1) one year contract position with the possibility of extension pending funding for the position and successful evaluation.
