

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Position: Water and Wastewater Support Operator – 1 year term

Summary: The Water and Wastewater Support Operator will be a part of the Matawa Technical Services team and will report to the Manager of Technical Services at the Thunder Bay office. Guidance and coordination will be provided by the Technical Services department. The Water and Wastewater Support Operator will also be required to respond to emergencies and assist the First Nations with addressing issues related to water and wastewater. The Support Operator will work closely with the Operators, Maintenance Technician, and contractors of the Water and Wastewater Treatment Plant Facilities and its subsidiary buildings in Matawa's nine First Nations communities.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- The ideal candidate would have a Class-1 or above Water Treatment, Water Distribution License and/or a Class-1 or Higher Wastewater Treatment License and Wastewater Collection License.
- As specified in O. Reg. 128/04 of the Safe Drinking Water Act and O. Reg. 129/04 of the Ontario Water Resources Act, Operator-in-training (OIT) may be considered. Entry Level Course (ELC) certificate required.
- Previous experience as a Water Treatment Plant Operator preferred.
- Minimum 2 years of post-secondary studies in environmental, chemical, or civil backgrounds would be an asset.
- Grade 12 level education or GED equivalency is mandatory

Salary: \$70,000- \$90,000 (annually)
