Position: Mental Wellness Team Lead Facilitator (3-month contract)

Summary:

The Mental Wellness Team Lead Facilitator works with nine (9) Mattawa First Nations to coordinate, develop and ensure that culturally appropriate community-based mental wellness and crisis response is provided. He/she is responsible for maintaining, recruiting, supervising the Matawa resources pool, multi-disciplinary teams and other mental wellness providers. He/she works closely with the First Nations to coordinate rapid crisis response and services as required. The Mental Wellness Team Lead Facilitator works under the direction and supervision of the Matawa Health & Social Meno Biimadeswin Director.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- College Diploma in Health Field study and/or Social Work; or Grade 12 equivalent with 3-4 years of work experience in crisis management or related social work, mental wellness.
- Must be willing to work flexible hours and on-call basis
- Extensive knowledge of mental wellness, emergency/crisis response & management, counselling, critical incident/trauma intervention and/or debriefing
- Good personnel management, leadership, supervisory and mentorship skills
