Position: Public Health Nurse - Long Lake #58 First Nation

Summary: The Public Health Nurse is responsible for planning, coordinating, and delivering comprehensive public health programs and services for the members of Long Lake #58 First Nation. The Public Health Nurse promotes health, prevents disease and injury, and supports the overall well-being of individuals, families, and the community through culturally appropriate health promotion, disease prevention, and health maintenance initiatives that respect Indigenous traditions and values. Working collaboratively with the health care team, community members, and leadership, the Public Health Nurse identifies local health priorities, provides assessments and recommendations to support patient care, and delivers public health services in a variety of settings, including homes, community facilities, and health centres. The Public Health Nurse also supports the ongoing development of safe and effective health services while fostering community education, wellness, and disease prevention initiatives.

- Excellent leadership, organizational and communication and problem-solving skills
