Position: Transitions to Care Coordinator

Background:

Formed in 1988, Matawa First Nations Management (Matawa) is a Tribal Council providing services to nine member communities in Northern Ontario. The organization provides its members with advisory and support services in the areas of communications, economic development, education, finance and business, health, membership, and technical services.

Reporting to the Director of Mental Wellness at the Matawa Health Co-operative, the Transitions to Care Coordinator's primary responsibilities will include providing day-to-day supervision, direction, and support to the Native Inmate Liaison Officers and implementing the Transitions in Care framework, which aims to provide an interconnected continuum-of-care approach for streamlining community health services for identified individuals preparing for or recently released from provincial correctional facilities. The successful candidate will liaise with incarcerated individuals and a network of local health care services, to ensure that these individuals have a healthcare reintegration plan with a focus on quality, equitable access, and culturally safe care.
